Areas will be labelled so please ensure that your artwork is being displayed in the correct category. Please bring a variety of hanging materials. If you are unable to bring work in person, you could ask another school geographically close to you, or another head who is attending, to bring it for you. If this is not possible then you will need to arrange delivery by courier for the day before (5th June) and include return labels. College's address is Oxford International College Brighton, Ovingdean Hall, Brighton, Greenways, East Sussex, BN2 7BA All artworks must have been entered by Monday 3rd June via the online entry form and have an official ISA entry label attached to the back or underneath. These can be downloaded from the ISA website National Art Competition Handbook ISA Art Competition (isaschools.org.uk) You should only be entering your best example of each type of work for each age group. This means that you CAN enter more than once in a category but only if the works are significantly different. For example, you may enter a watercolour landscape by a Year 2 pupil and a mixed media portrait by a Year 1 pupil in the KS1 2D category but not two watercolour landscapes. Judging will start as soon as possible after 4.15 pm after all work has been put on display. Afternoon Tea will be available whilst judging takes place and results announced at approximately 5.45 pm - 6pm. After judging, and announcement of results, work may be collected. Work that is placed first in any category must be taken back and stored by the entering school ready to be taken to the National Finals in November.
