### ISA Digital Art Competition 2024 Rules and Guidelines



#### • Eligibility

This competition is open to ISA Members' schools only. Each school may submit a maximum of two entries per age category.

At ISA, we are committed to making our opportunities accessible, we welcome applications from all pupils, including those with learning difficulties or disabilities.

Alternative formats of these guidelines are available on request. Please notify us at the earliest opportunity so we can provide the document accordingly, if required..

#### Age groups

- EYFS
- Key Stage 1
- Key Stage 2
- Key Stage 3
- Key Stage 4-5

#### Categories

- a. Photo collage/photo manipulation
   (any artwork created by digitally manipulating or combining one or multiple photographs)
- b. Digital drawing or vector art

   (any artwork created entirely digitally using drawing or vector art software)

#### Rules

- Submissions can be any art produced using the aid of computers, tablets or other digital devices. This
  includes digitally edited photography, as well as art produced using design software, or creative
  programmes.
- All work submitted should be entered for the age category which applied when the work was produced and should not have been previously submitted.
- Staff must confirm that all work submitted is the student's own; if there has been any staff input, including technician assistance, this must be declared on the entry form.
- Each participant must have a full copyright of their submitted work. Participant must ensure that the
  artwork submitted does not breach copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or
  intellectual property rights of any person or entity.

All the copyrights belong to the participant. However, ISA reserves the right to showcase the artworks on the ISA website and social media and to use them for marketing purposes. Please note that the name of the student might also be displayed.

- Judging criteria
- Technique (drawing, editing etc.)
- Creativity
- Overall impression of artwork
- How to enter

Artwork must be submitted in JPEG or PNG format only, maximum size 10 MB.

Please name your file with the school name followed by the pupil name e.g. SchoolName\_JohnSmith.

Entries must be submitted via the entry form on the ISA website by **Wednesday 27 March 2024** at the latest.
