• Eligibility

This competition is open to ISA Members' schools only. Schools can submit a maximum of nine entries in total, spread across the categories below. One entry only per pupil per category. Competition open to all age groups. We encourage schools to run a competition in house and to submit their best entries.

At ISA, we are committed to enabling all eligible and talented pupils to enter our events and competitions. Our opportunities are fully inclusive, and we welcome applications from pupils with apparent or non-apparent disabilities.

Rules

- All entries must be the participants' original work, which has never been published
- Digital art is allowed
- Entries for the covers must be portrait only
- Entries must not include any writing
- Entries must be submitted as JPEG or PNG file only

All the copyrights belong to the participant. However, ISA reserves the right to showcase the artworks on the ISA website and social media and to use them for marketing purposes. Please note that the name of the student might also be displayed.
