It is the schools' responsibility to organise delivery as well as collection of their artwork for the regionals events as well as the finals therefore, it's important to consider the size and weight of the artwork submitted in the competition.

**Open for entries:** Tuesday 1 September 2026

**Deadline for entries:** Tuesday 29 September 2026

**Date of event:** Tuesday 6 October 2026

**Venue:** Norden Farm Centre for the Arts, Altwood Road, Maidenhead, SL6 4PF

### **Delivery instructions:**

Schools should bring their work from 9am to Norden Farm where there will be exhibition boards and display areas for you to arrange your work. Flat work such as work on paper should have strips of velcro hooks applied for easy mounting on the exhibition boards.

If unable to attend, schools can choose to send work by courier to the above location but must know that the ISA accepts no responsibility for any work damaged and schools must also arrange collection swiftly after the event.

We expect the competition to end at around 3pm for schools to take down and collect their work.
