

First race: 12.30pm

Parking

There is hard standing parking on site. Car parking charges will apply (pay and display).

Facilities

Changing rooms are not available and runners should come ready to race. Toilets are located on site. Athletes must **NOT** rinse shoes in the toilets.

Race Briefing

Meet at the race briefing area 5 minutes before your start time. Runners will move into the start pens 2 minutes before the race.

Results

Given the nature and complexity of the event, results on the day can take time to be checked and approved. Consequently, this may mean a delay with the race results. Please do not expect these to be published instantly.

Presentations

- Medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishers at the end of each race.
- Team awards will be calculated using a combined placing of juniors, seniors, and overall. These results will be calculated and published after the event.

Junior Races: 10 competitors from each Area (6 count towards team points)

Senior Races: 10 competitors from each Area (4 count towards team points)
