Rules

- Each team registered is a maximum of 4 players per age group gender
- Rules are as per Table Tennis England guidance and can be found on the TTE website: (https://tabletennisengland.co.uk/compete/rules-regs/laws/)
- Each match will consist of best of three games to 11 points (unless stated otherwise)
- In the event of a game reaching 10 points each, the game must be won by two clear points
- Pupils are to score and umpire their own matches
- Winner of each match will record the score at the appropriate results desk
- We will ask team managers to help oversee each results desk throughout the day.
- Balls will be provided by ISA.

Equipment:

Players are expected to wear suitable non-marking footwear in the sports hall. Own equipment is essential with changing rooms provided.

Parking:

If parking outside the David Ross Sports Village is busy, there is parking on Beeston Lane at the bottom of the DRSV drive (pay and display).

Spectators:

There is limited seating around the table tennis salle, so spectators should be restricted as much as possible.
