Online deadline for entries: Friday 19 September 2025.

Date of event: Thursday 2 October 2025.

## **Delivery instructions:**

Artwork submitted online will need to be brought to The Marriott Hotel, Waltham Abbey, EN9 3LX on Thursday 2 October between 8.30 and 9.30am either in-person or via courier.

Work delivered via courier to The Marriott Hotel must arrive the day before the event (Wednesday 1 October.) Schools must give details of all the pieces sent via courier, please email Emma Mistry — <a href="maistry@ahsprep.co.uk">emistry@ahsprep.co.uk</a> regarding this.

You need to complete a paper entry form for each piece you have entered online. These can be found in the handbook and attached to the back of artworks. This is so we know which category to put it in, and so we know which winner to announce. Details of how to complete this form are in the handbook. Categories are also in the handbook.

Each piece of work that can be hung needs to have Velcro on the back. A piece in each corner is good.

Please do not hang your own work when you arrive. Just put in the pile for the correct category. All work will be checked it is in the correct place and then hung for you.

#### **Collection:**

Work needs to be collected from 2.30pm on Thursday 2 October 2025.

Collection of pieces sent via courier will need to be organised by schools.

Any work left after 3.30pm will need collecting from Avon House School at a later date, this applies to courier and in-person collections.
