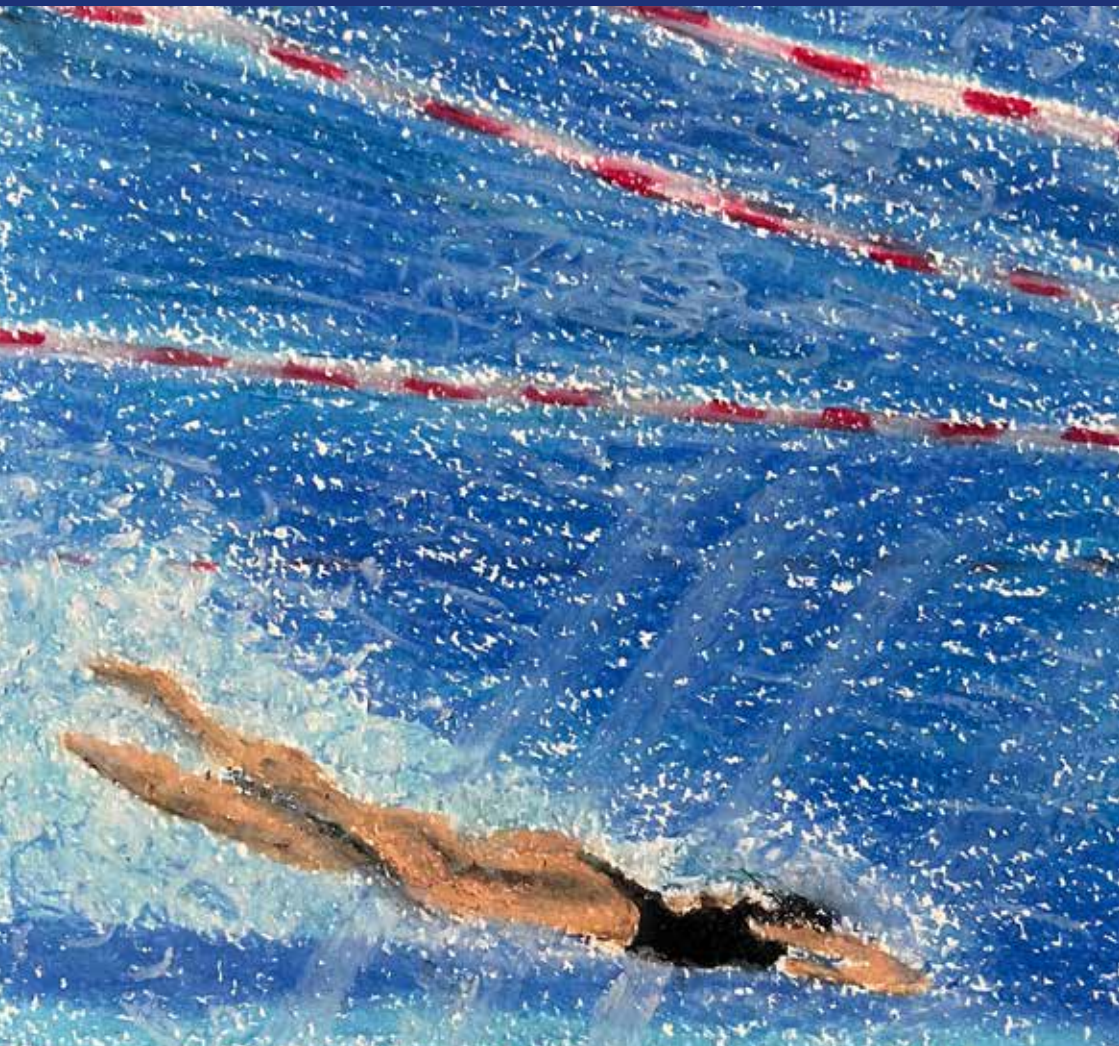

Event Details

This event is not a licensed meet.

Spectators

Spectator seating is on the opposite side of the concourse to the registration desks. **STRICTLY NO SPECTATORS** (including parents) will be allowed to sit with the Area teams in the competitor seating area.

Changing Facilities

STRICTLY NO SPECTATORS (including parents) will be allowed in the changing facilities at any time. Changing area access is restricted to staff members wearing a lanyard. Changing facilities and lockers are available. Phones are strictly prohibited in the changing rooms. Competitors must **NOT** take any belongings onto poolside, except for a towel, footwear and t-shirt for presentations. Kit bags should be kept in lockers.

Food and Drink

Only competitors are allowed food and drink in the venue. Spectators can buy food from the concession trolleys or at the cafe.

Each year group has a lane for their warm-up session.

Points will be awarded for each race as follows:

Rules

- Swim England rules apply to this event.
- All competitors must qualify via their Area to compete at the National Finals.
- Competitors may enter a maximum of 2 individual races and 2 relays.
- 'Over the top' starts will operate at the discretion of the referee.
- Competitors who do not wish to dive into the pool to start their race may start in the water.
- All year 4,5,6,7,8 and butterfly races are 50m (1 length)
- All year 9/10 and 11+ races are 100m (2 lengths)
- All relay races and Individual Medley's are 200m (4 lengths)

Disputes on the day

- The referee's decision is final.
- If you wish to protest about a decision made on the day, you must protest within half an hour of the decision being made, in writing to the referee.

A warm welcome to GB Guest Athlete, David Hill...

David was a Paralympic swimmer, international medallist, and elite Para Triathlete for over 15 years. He competed in the Athens 2004 Paralympics as the Youngest British Athlete, became British Champion in 2014 and was a Top 10 finisher in the Rio de Janeiro 2016 Paralympic Games.

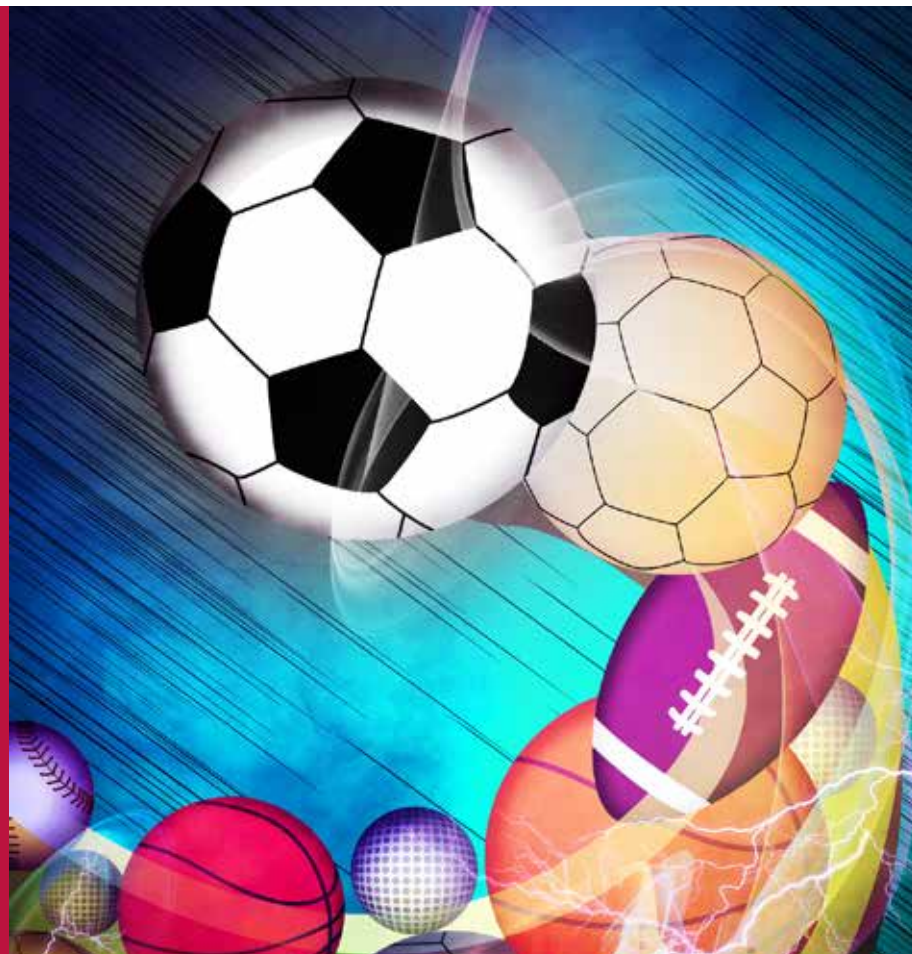
