- **Eligibility**

This competition is open to ISA Members' schools only. Artworks can be made by individuals or groups. Schools can submit a maximum of ten entries in total. We encourage schools to run a competition in house first and submit their best entries.

To enter the competition, you must submit a JPEG photograph of the artwork.

Artworks can be created in any 2D or 3D medium.
