8:30-9:30 – Bring in work that has been previously submitted online for display. Original artwork must be submitted, not a photograph.

Work to be placed in the correct group area on the floor. Please don't start hanging work – this will be done for you when all the artwork has arrived.

No multiple canvas artwork is to be submitted as they are difficult to be displayed and pieced together at the National Final.

Once you have dropped off the work, please leave the gallery and help yourself to coffee etc, read the programme of events and sign up to the Instagram account to see the winners.

9:30 – judging to commence – winners to be announced via the Instagram account and then later via email.

9:30 – 11:30 – CPD Workshop. (Break half way)

'Art Enrichment in schools'

Art teachers to share ideas about how art enriches their curriculum.

- For example: Arts Week? Activities week? various workshops or visits throughout the year?
- Bring in examples of timetabling across the school – mid-term, yearly, weekly etc
- How does the school choose an artist?
- Are all staff on board with any type of 'arts week' or other activity that you prepare but they don't usually teach.
- School trips - Do you create an activity sheet for children to complete once they are at the exhibition?

- Visiting Artists – one off or related to topic / curriculum
- Final exhibition for parents?
- Any other ideas / suggestions that have worked well in your school.

11:30 – 12:00 – Art teachers can visit the exhibition.

12:00-13:00 – lunch. **PLEASE NOTE THAT HEADS WILL NEED TO BOOK A LUNCH FOR THEMSELVES AND THE ART TEACHERS.**

1300 – talk from judges to art teachers and heads. Results will have been announced via WhatsApp group as they happened. Results will be typed up and sent out to schools via email by the end of the week.

Art teachers can collect their art.

1st placed artworks: Will need to submit a high-quality photograph of the work to ISA Arts (isaarts@isaschools.org.uk) which will be used in their online gallery and printed brochure. Winners will still need to deliver the actual artwork to the final.
