## ISA NATIONAL CHORAL CELEBRATION 2021 – GUIDELINES

ISA is delighted to invite you to take part in the National Choral Celebration on **Friday 7 May 2021**, at **Tettenhall College**, Wood Rd, Tettenhall, Wolverhampton WV6 8QX. **Deadline to enter Wednesday 7 April**. Please note that entry numbers for this workshop are limited for this event, don't delay your entry.

- **Eligibility**

This event is open to ISA Members' Schools only.

Schools can submit only one entry per age group (9-11 or 11-14), and two entries in total.

- **Age group:**

There are two sessions:

- Morning Session 1 (from 10.00 to 12.30): Ages 9-11
- Morning Session 2 (from 14.00 to 16.30): Ages 11-14

Your school can enter one group per session only.

A group can be up to 25 pupils and up to 3 adult participants. There is no option for spectators.

All adults in attendance will be expected to participate fully and enthusiastically in all singing activities, as role models for this large group of singers.

The afternoon session will also be designed to be accessible for boys with changing voices.

- **Schedule**

Arrivals/registration from 09.30 for the first session.

Arrivals/registration from 13.30 for the second session.

Due to the scale of this event and the number of schools involved, we ask that schools leave promptly at the end of their session and do not arrive before the stated time.

- **Music and preparation prior to the event**

All music will be sung by ear, no handouts will be needed or allowed.

No prior experience necessary.

- **Practicalities**

Schools must bring their packed lunches and refreshments.

We ask pupils to wear their school uniforms.

- **How to enter**

Entries must be submitted via the online entry form on the ISA website [www.isaschools.org.uk](http://www.isaschools.org.uk) by Thursday 4 February 2021. Please note that there are limited places for the event, don't delay your entry.

\* Before submitting an entry, you must have obtained appropriate permissions from your Head/HoD for pupil and staff absence from school, including appropriate cover for staff and any associated costs.

Please note, entries are limited, if you book a slot then subsequently cancel, you may be preventing another school from this opportunity. In addition, late cancellations cause considerable inconvenience to the organisers. An entry received should be regarded as a definite commitment to attend.
